Staff updates

As a Board, we have identified a few key areas of operational improvement from seasons past and have made an adjustment to the staff structure to support facilitating those improvements.

It was decided by our board in March that SAMHA would create a new position of Executive Director for the Association. The role was established to provide more support for the important off-ice work of strengthening relationships with Sponsors, Donors, the Rec Society, City Hall, local Arena schedulers, our board, volunteers, and to bolster the operational structure of the Association which will improve the delivery of hockey programing for our members.

We are pleased to formally announce the hiring of Jason Brown who has been working in the role since April. Jason has been a volunteer coach and board member who is entering his fourth season with Salmon Arm Minor Hockey. We believe that the addition of Jason as a leader among our staff will improve the product both on and off the ice.

This move was made with the intention of maintaining the position of Manager of Hockey Operations, and the responsibilities of that role will become much more heavily focused on player and coach development both on and off the ice.

Many of you will have had the pleasure of working with our Manager of Hockey Operations, Cole Slaney for the past two seasons. Throughout his time with us, Cole was always very forthright in his desire to pursue other career opportunities as they arose, and in May the decision was made that Cole would be moving on from his role as Manager of Hockey Operations.

We would like to thank Cole for the years of dedicated service to Minor Hockey here in Salmon Arm and recognize the contributions he's made along the way for the many families, and players who he's worked with during his tenure.

Of course, with change comes opportunity, and we are excited to be actively working to hire a replacement for the work Cole was handling. We are currently interviewing a short list of very highly qualified and experienced candidates for the part-time role of Director of Hockey Development.

Startup & Season Schedule
